## **Trustees' Annual Report**

Charity name: Reggie Gadsby Foundation

Charity number: 1206482

Constitutional form: Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO)

## **Objectives and Activities**

The charity's object, as stated in its constitution, is:

"For the public benefit, to assist in the treatment and care of persons of any age in the United Kingdom, suffering from mental or physical illness of any description or in need of rehabilitation as a result of such illness by the provision of financial assistance and support."

In pursuit of this object, the Foundation aims to provide grants to individuals and organisations supporting people affected by mental or physical illness, in line with its published Grant Making Policy.

## **Achievements and Performance**

The 2024/25 financial year was the first year of operation. The trustees focused on:

- Registering the CIO with the Charity Commission,
- Opening a bank account and JustGiving fundraising platform,
- Developing policies including the Grant Making Policy,

- Beginning initial fundraising efforts.

During the year the Foundation raised £5,028.81 in donations from individuals and fundraising platforms. Expenditure consisted of £162.00 in JustGiving subscription fees. The resulting year-end balance was £4,866.81. No grants were distributed before the financial year-end, but the trustees expect to award the majority of the available funds in 2025/26, with initial grants anticipated to the national pregnancy-loss charities Tommy's, 4Louis and Aching Arms subject to trustee approval.

### **Public Benefit**

The trustees confirm they have had regard to the Charity Commission's guidance on public benefit. The Foundation's activities are directed towards people in the UK experiencing mental or physical illness, where financial support can improve their treatment, care or rehabilitation.

### **Who Benefits**

Beneficiaries include:

- Individuals with diagnosed mental or physical illness who demonstrate financial need.
- UK-based charitable organisations supporting such individuals.

The charity's work is national in scope but initially focused on grants to reputable UK-wide organisations.

### **Structure, Governance and Management**

The Foundation is a Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO) governed by its constitution.

The trustees during the year were:

- Thomas Gadsby (Chair)
- Sophie Gadsby
- Vivien Gadsby

The trustees meet to agree strategy, consider grant applications, and oversee compliance and financial management.

### **Financial Review**

Total income in the year was £5,028.81, all from voluntary donations. Total expenditure was £162.00 (JustGiving platform subscription fees). The year-end bank balance was £4,866.81. The charity's only assets are cash funds held at the bank.

### **Reserves Policy**

Given the current level of activity, the trustees do not hold reserves beyond amounts required to meet committed grants and necessary operational expenses. This policy will be reviewed annually.

### **Additional Compliance Sections**

Statement of Trustees' Responsibilities:

The trustees are responsible for preparing the Trustees' Annual Report and the financial statements in accordance with applicable law and UK GAAP. They are required to keep proper records and safeguard the assets of the charity.

### **Basis of Accounting**


These accounts have been prepared on a Receipts and Payments basis in accordance with the Charities Act 2011 and Charity Commission guidance.
