*The financial statements have - been prepared under the historical cost convention except for the valuation of investment assets, which are shown at market value.*

#### *Funds:*

*Unrestricted funds represent the funds that are not subject to any restrictions regarding their use and are available for use in furtherance of the objectives of the Church. Restricted funds are those donated for use in a particular area or for specific purposes.*

*The accounts include all transactions, assets and liabilities for which the Trustees are responsible in law. They do not include the accounts of church groups that owe their main affiliation to another body nor those that are informal gatherings of Church members.*
