##### Objectives and aims

The prevention or relief of poverty in Rochdale Borough particularly for young people by providing:-

- recycled and good quality school uniform
- other clothing and footwear items to individuals in need
- to charities or other organisations working to prevent or relieve poverty that they could not otherwise afford

##### Public benefit

The trustees have given due regard to the guidance published on the charity commission website and are satisfied that the charity has met the conditions relating to public benefit.

### REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES FOR THE PERIOD 16 JANUARY 2024 TO 31 MARCH 2025

#### ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE

##### Charitable activities

We continue to serve Rochdale, Heywood, Middleton and Pennine families with recycled uniforms. We currently have items for 76 primary schools and 25 secondary schools. Our premises at Globe House are 300 square feet. At our busiest time, receiving 120 requests in 2 days.

Throughout the year we have given out 15,000 uniforms and helped 2,000 families. The average cost per item is £15 (new) and as such we have saved families a total of £225,000. The average weight of each item is 200 grams, therefore we have saved 3.3 tons of textile waste from landfill.

#### FINANCIAL REVIEW

##### Reserves policy

The charity looks to maintain general reserves of £5,000. As at the year end the charity had general reserves of £3,384. The trustees continue to work hard with funding applications.

#### FUTURE DEVELOPMENTS

The charity is extremely dependent upon the voluntary hours put in by the chair of trustees. The charity has applied for funding to give paid employment of 16 hours per week to another unrelated party, but sadly this was declined. The trustees will need to give careful consideration as to whether the charity can continue in its current form without further funding.

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention, and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008), the Charities Act 2011 and the requirements of the Statement of Recommended Practice, Accounting and Reporting by Charities.

Incoming resources

All incoming resources are included on the Statement of Financial Activities when the charity is legally entitled to the income and the amount can be quantified with reasonable accuracy.

Resources expended

Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Taxation

The charity is exempt from tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.
