Objectives and Activities

Aims and Objectives

The charity's objects are the prevention or relief of poverty or financial hardship, particularly within Africa, by providing or assisting in the provision of education, training, healthcare, water and sanitation initiatives, and other forms of support intended to enable individuals and communities to become self-sufficient.

The charity is established to operate internationally, including in Nigeria, where its long-term aims include the future support of programmes relating to healthcare provision, education, access to clean water, and community development.

During the financial period, the charity did not undertake any trading or charitable activities, and no programmes were delivered in the UK or overseas. The period was used to establish the charity's governance, compliance, and administrative framework in preparation for future charitable operations.

1. General Information

OB Lulu-Briggs Foundation is a charitable incorporated organisation registered with the Charity Commission, registered charity number 1206849. The principal address is Berkeley Square House, Mayfair, London, W1J 6BD.

2. Accounting Policies

2.1. Basis of Preparation of Financial Statements

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) "Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)", Financial Reporting Standard 102 "The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland" and the Charities Act 2011.

The charity is a Public Benefit Entity as defined by FRS 102.
