**Objectives and Activities**

The Longwave Foundation is established for charitable purposes, with a focus on delivering public benefit through targeted grant-making and support to individuals and organisations aligned with its mission. The trustees have had regard to the Charity Commission's guidance on public benefit in determining the charity's objectives and activities.

During the period under review, the charity's principal focus was on organisational development and ensuring that appropriate foundations were in place to support future operations.

**Activities for the Period**

No direct charitable activities or grant-making took place during the reporting period. This was due to the charity being in a preparatory phase, during which the trustees prioritised:
