The trustees have had regard to guidance issued by the Charity Commission on public benefit. While no public benefit was delivered in the period because no funds were raised meaning that no grants could be made, the trustees' activities in the period have been aimed at getting the charity on an operational footing, as further described in section D, so that the charity is able to deliver public benefit in future. In the period, the trustees received regular reports on the activities of UL Ice Hockey Trust, supporting the educational and amateur sports activities of which is the charity's primary purpose.

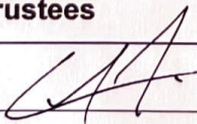
