
Policies and Objectives

In setting objectives and planning for activities, the Trustees have given due consideration to general guidance published by the Charity Commission relating to public benefit.


Going Concern



Notes to the Financial Statements

Period Ended 31 December 2024

General Information

The Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO) was registered on 15 February 2024, with a reporting date of 31 December 2024. During the period, the entity was dormant with the trading activity being recorded in the RSPCA Cotswolds, Gloucester & District Branch, an unincorporated association. The trade and assets of the unincorporated entity are to be incorporated to the CIO during the period to 31 December 2025.

Accounting Policies

Basis of Preparation of Financial Statements

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) - Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102).

RSPCA Cotswolds, Gloucester & District Branch CIO meets the definition of a public benefit entity under FRS 102. Assets and liabilities are initially recognised at historical cost or transaction value unless otherwise stated in the relevant accounting policy.
