The Charity, now in its second year, has been working closely with schools, public sector, voluntary sector and faith groups to offer training to trusted adults, which can support children where they have a parent/carers with poor mental health (diagnosed or not).

At the beginning of 2025 Clare Hurren (Founder) became part time – 2 days a week for The Charity and stood down as a Trustee. This enabled SWM to deliver more training, devise resources, surveys and outcome measurements. At the end of 2026 she returned full time to her employment and SWM advertised for a new Charity Development Manager.

In December 2026 they appointed Rachael Wyartt to the position, and she commenced in early 2027. Rachael runs her own Coaching, Consultancy and Training company and has the skills to take on leadership, with the support of a very committed Trustee Board.

Rachael helped to found Framlingham Area Youth Action Partnership (FAYAP) and has voluntary experience as well as experience of supporting young people where their mental health may have been affected. She has received Mental Health 1st Aid Training since beginning her new employment and came with a wealth of skills and qualifications relevant to the post.
