It is with great pleasure that I present the Trustees' Annual Report for Quest Academy Parents Association (QAPA).


This reporting period reflects our early development as a Charitable Incorporated Organisation and our continued commitment to supporting pupils, families and the wider community of Quest Academy.

A significant highlight has been the generous support received in the form of donated goods, facilities and services, which has strengthened our ability to support the school community.


As we look ahead, we aim to build on these foundations by expanding engagement, increasing fundraising, and continuing to provide meaningful support to pupils and families.



**2023 QAPA AUTUMN UPDATE**

- Enrichment Donations**  
We have obtained £17063 worth of donations of equipment and educational aids to support enrichment classes over the Autumn term.
- Parent Forum**  
The monthly Forum has families and staff invited to talk about important issues and fundraising. We have provided refreshments worth £75.94 and also run Pre-loved Uniform sales at these events.
- Coats for students in need**  
We have teamed up with WrapUp London and Playground to obtain £200 worth of winter coats for students in need.
- Quiz Night**  
Our Quiz Night at the end of last year raised £63.80. The quiz night with pizza, donuts and refreshments proved popular, with the winners receiving prizes.
- Other Support**  
We provided the Quest Academy with £33.98 worth of equipment for educational use. We also supported the school Open days by handing out information and answering questions.
- Other Social Events**  
We held our first Dinner Dance and End of Term Dinners. These were lovely evenings and a chance for people to let their hair down at the end of term.
- Sports Day House Cup**  
We have started raising funds for the Sports Day House Cup. So far we have raised 1/6 of the cost of the Cup. £104.95.
- QAPA Online**  
We have set up our own website with Sun Up which takes payments and accepts donations. We have set up Classlist for parents and carers to connect with one another.



**QAPA Winter Update 2023/4**

- Enrichment Donations**  
We have obtained another £200 worth of donations of educational aids to support enrichment classes over the Winter term.
- Quiz Night**  
Our Quiz Night raised £197. The quiz night with pizza, donuts and refreshments proved popular, with the winners receiving prizes.
- Other Support**  
Throughout the winter term we have maintained the allotment for classes in the Spring.

It is my pleasure to present the Trustees' Annual Report for Quest Academy Parents Association (QAPA) for the year ended August 2025.


During 2024-5, the charity maintained a limited level of activity while preserving its charitable purpose and governance arrangements.

The trustees kept the organisation under review throughout the year and ensured that the charity remained in a position to continue its work in future periods.


