Structure, governance and management

Women and Children Relief is registered as a Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO) and it was registered as a charity on 6th March 2024.

The charity was established under a constitution, which established the objects and powers of the charitable company.

The directors, who are the trustees in charity law are responsible for the overall management and control of the company working with other persons on an entirely voluntary basis.

Trustees are appointed in accordance with Women and Children Relief constitution. Once appointed, Trustees are given introduction of the charity and information about its objects, Trustees are also given the copy of the constitution and aims and objective, Role description are issued to each trustee and an induction is given setting out the obligations of a trustee. All trustees are issued with copies of the Charity Commission's guidance.

The trustees meet every 3 months.
