Financial Review

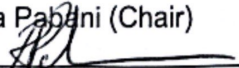

The trustees are responsible for preparing the Trustees' Annual Report and accounts in accordance with applicable law and Charity Commission guidance.

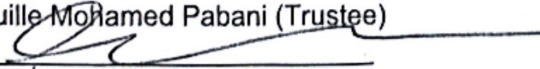

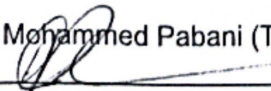
