1. Reference and Administrative Details

Trustees: Trustees of the charity are responsible for the governance and direction of the organisation.

2. Objectives and Purposes

The purpose of EL SADAI ROMANIAN CHURCH is to advance the Christian faith and serve the local community through spiritual teaching, prayer, fellowship and charitable support.

The church seeks to promote the message of the Gospel of Jesus Christ and to provide spiritual care and encouragement to individuals and families within the Romanian and wider community in London.

The charity operates for the public benefit in accordance with the guidance issued by the Charity Commission for England and Wales.

3. Activities During the Year

- weekly worship services
- prayer meetings
- Bible teaching and preaching
- pastoral care and spiritual counselling
- fellowship meetings for families and believers
- community support for people in need

Through these activities the church aimed to strengthen faith, encourage unity among believers and bring hope and spiritual support to those facing difficult circumstances.

4. Public Benefit

The church provides spiritual services, guidance and community support which are open to members of the public and contribute positively to the wellbeing of the community.

Expenditure covered the running costs of the church and the support of its activities, including operational expenses and ministry-related costs.

Trustees meet as necessary to review the activities and financial position of the charity and to ensure that the organisation continues to operate in accordance with its charitable purposes.
