The purpose of the Charity are

Provide ecosystem for amateur and professional artists to develop.

celebrate diversity of cultures in our society by promoting art forms through presentations by, and with, artists of different cultural backgrounds

Putting these strategies into action we intent to initiate the activities in major areas like workshops, stage performances, educational programs.

Plan for future periods:

The Trustees have agreed to open bank account with Metro Bank as community current & savings accounts, HMRC registration towards obtaining Gift Aid recognition. We also agreed to develop Trustees expense management policy, our pricing policy for ticketed events, and the reserve policy and implement them.

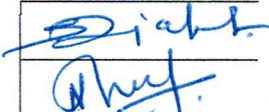
