- During the year, the charity undertook several key activities in furtherance of its objectives and for the benefit of the public. The trustees confirm that they have had due regard to the guidance issued by the Charity Commission on public benefit when planning and delivering these activities.
- The charity successfully conducted **three evangelism drives across East London**, promoting community outreach, engagement, and spiritual enrichment. Regular worship and ministry activities were maintained with **over 90% operational consistency**, ensuring that services continued without significant interruption.
- To enhance worship experience and service delivery, the charity **acquired essential service equipment** and **established an additional weekly online service**, expanding accessibility to those unable to attend physically. Over the course of the year, more than **20 livestream services** were successfully delivered, further strengthening our online presence and connection with the wider community.
- In fostering a sense of community and shared faith, the charity **christened a baby and dedicated a baby**, celebrating key family milestones within the congregation. Additionally, we held a **Friendship Sunday**, a special outreach initiative that encouraged members to invite friends and members of the public. The event created a platform for participants to **share personal testimonies, wins, and challenges**, reinforcing bonds of fellowship and mutual support.
