Objectives and activities

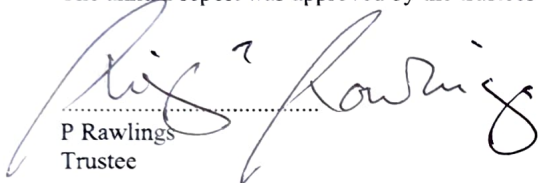
Public benefit

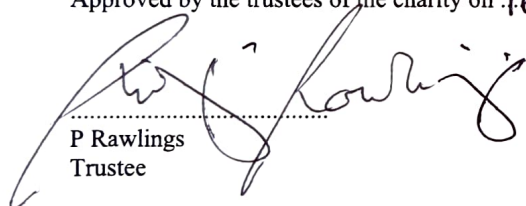

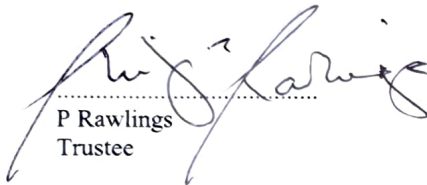

1 Accounting policies

Statement of compliance
