The advancement of education for the benefit of people with disabilities by the provision of a hydrotherapy pool facility.

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Summary of the main activities undertaken for the public benefit in relation to these objects (include within this section the statutory declaration that trustees have had regard to the guidance issued by the Charity Commission on public benefit)

The charity provides a hydrotherapy facility for the benefit of people with temporary or permanent disabilities. The hydrotherapy pool helps people with disabilities to exercise effectively and can assist in the treatment and management of certain disabilities. The disability could be physical, mental or both. This hydrotherapy facility is open 7 days and 60 hours a week. A requirement of use of the facility is that beneficiaries must have a referral from a medical practitioner, to allow the charity to use their resources at those most in need. The charity provides education through provision of physio-led sessions to allow beneficiaries to make best use of the hydrotherapy facilities, and to ensure that they are using the facility effectively to treat or rehabilitate the disability. The hydrotherapy pool is often used to support the work of external organisations such as special needs schools, adult/elderly care establishments or support groups for specific conditions.

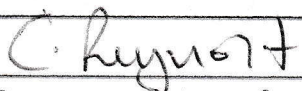
The principal source of funds will come from pool admission charges and fundraising. The Association remains a privately run charity and receives no financial support from the local borough council or health authority.
