Jak's World was established to support mental wellbeing and suicide prevention through accessible community-based activities, creative engagement, and peer support. The charity aims to reduce isolation, promote emotional wellbeing, and create safe spaces for individuals to connect and heal.

Activities and achievements

During the period, the charity delivered a range of wellbeing and community support activities, including sessions under the Hopeful Horizons initiative. These activities were offered free at the point of access and focused on promoting mental wellbeing, connection, and emotional resilience within the community.

Public benefit

Financial review

During the period, the charity received income primarily from donations and small-scale fundraising.
