The charity does not have any reserve policy.

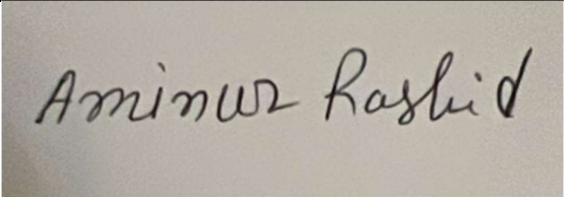
No funds are in deficit at the balance sheet.

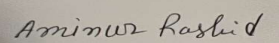
