INSANIYAT FOUNDATION is constituted as a Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO) - Foundation Model, where the sole voting member is the charity Trustee. We have adopted a model constitution to ensure full compliance with the Charities Act 2011, as amended by the Charities Act 2022 and General Regulations, ensuring we:

- Reflect recommended best practice; and
- Are legally compliant.

Appointment of Trustees

The initial Trustee, Faraha Azeem, was appointed on 19 July 2024, bringing essential leadership and vision for the charity's effective administration and development. Future trustees will be appointed based on their knowledge, experience, and skills, ensuring a diverse and competent Board.

Trustees are screened to ensure a suitable skills mix on the Board, mitigate potential risks, and reduce conflicts of interest.
