The Experience Bank is a Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO).
Trustees are appointed under the terms of the constitution.
No staff or volunteers were active during the year.

C. Objectives and Activities

Charitable Objects

The objects for which the CIO is established are to provide relief amongst children and young people (up to the age of 25 years old) seeking asylum and those granted refugee status who have been the victim of human trafficking, modern slavery or exploitation, including unaccompanied asylum-seeking children (UASCs) who have been separated from their parents or carers.

Activities in the Reporting Period

The Experience Bank had not begun delivering charitable activities during this financial year. The trustees focused on establishing governance, setting up operations, and early planning for services.

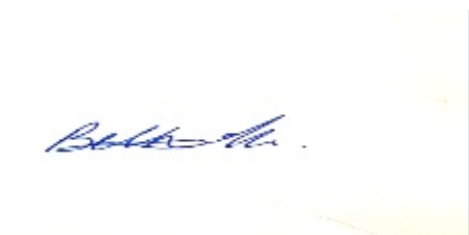
