The charity will take over the activities of the preexisting unincorporated charity of the same name and all activities, assets and operations will be officially moved to the newly registered charity on 1st June 2025.

Trustees are appointed for a 3 year term by the members of the Church at a general meeting. The Trustees named above served through-out the period unless otherwise indicated.

The Church is autonomous, and financially self-supporting and is voluntarily affiliated to the Fellowship of Independent Evangelical Churches.

Achievements and performance

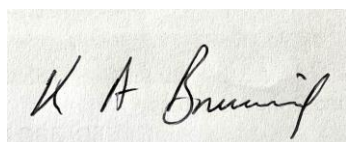
The activities of the charity in this financial period consisted solely of establishing the new charity and preparations for the transfer of the activities of the previously unincorporated charity on 1st June 2025.
