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2. Structure, Governance and Management

Aiderbichl Animal Aid UK is a Charitable Incorporated Organisation governed by its constitution. The charity is managed by its trustees, who are responsible for the overall governance, strategy, and direction of the charity.

Trustees are appointed in accordance with the charity's governing document. During the period, the trustees met as required to organise the charity's governance arrangements and to

oversee the establishment of its operational and strategic foundations. All trustees give their time voluntarily and receive no remuneration.

3. Objectives and Activities

Charitable Purposes

The charity's purposes, as set out in its constitution, are:

- I. For the public benefit, to promote human morality by encouraging kindness to animals and discouraging cruelty to animals in the United Kingdom.**
- II. To relieve the suffering of animals in need of care and attention in Romania, Hungary, Austria, Germany, France, Switzerland and the United Kingdom by providing grant funding to Gut Aiderbichl and similar organisations providing relief to animals in need in these regions.**

Activities During the Year

As this was the charity's first reporting period, activities focused on establishment and preparation for future charitable delivery. Activities undertaken included:

- Registering the charity and establishing its governance structure
- Organising the trustees and defining trustee roles and responsibilities
- Preparing key policy documents, including safeguarding and governance policies
- Setting up the charity's website and social media presence
- Developing strategies to meet the charity's charitable objectives and long-term goals
- Establishing donation systems in preparation for public fundraising
- Undertaking logistical and operational planning for the year ahead
- Developing a communications and social media strategy

No public fundraising or grant-making activities took place during the reporting period.

4. Achievements, Performance and Public Benefit

The trustees have had due regard to the Charity Commission's guidance on public benefit.

Although no direct charitable activities were delivered during the period, the trustees believe that the preparatory work undertaken is necessary and appropriate to enable the charity to deliver public benefit in future periods. This work will support the promotion of animal welfare, the discouragement of cruelty to animals, and the provision of support to organisations that relieve animal suffering in the regions identified in the charity's objects.

7. Custodian Trustee Funds

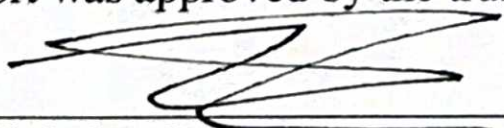
The charity did **not** hold any funds as a custodian trustee on behalf of other charities or organisations during the reporting period.

The charity held no assets and had no liabilities at the end of the reporting period.

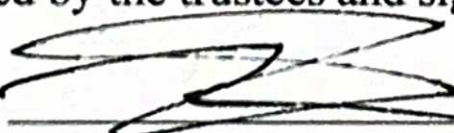
5. Trustee remuneration
