Pastoral and Care Ministry: In the report period, we organized cell groups / fellowship gatherings. Our gatherings brought forth activities such as bible studies, communication, sharing in faith, prayer meetings, etc, aiming to give pastoral support and promote spiritual health. 4. Evangelistic and Outreach Ministry - A Mid-Autumn Festival event (20/9/2025) - In May 2025, the church held a community service event to collect second-hand clothing and donated the items to the Rainbow Charity Shop in the name of the church. - In May 2025, we organized a briefing and speaking practice sessions to help HKers to achieve B1 level English.

Para 1.20	1. Weekly Sunday Service and building spiritual Life Our church has held our weekly Sunday worship, with an average attendance of approximately forty-six people. Two baptisms were held on September 22, 2024, and August 31, 2025. Three people joined the baptisms and became our Church members. A founding worship service was held on September 29, 2024, and its first anniversary celebration was held on September 28, 2025. Trainings were provided for the worship service leaders to improve the quality of worship. 2. Education and Training Established a children's church with a stable number of participating children, averaging about fifteen to twenty attendees. Conducted Alpha course to help believers take root in the truth. Trained small group leaders, with 8 participants. 3. Pastoral and Care Ministry: In the report period, we have 3 cell groups and 2 fellowship groups, with a total of approximately 50-60 participants.
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		4. Evangelistic and Outreach Ministry A Mid-Autumn Festival event was held, with approximately 200 participants. The event included five booths and performances by four groups. To help HKers to achieve B1 level English, a briefing and three speaking practice sessions were held in May 2025, with 18 students enrolled and 35 attendees. Ten volunteer instructors assisted. "Luminaries" with 5 training sessions were held in September 2025 to enhance communication skills for teenagers, with five teenagers participating and actively engaging in the training. Hong Kong Ladies is an open group, provides support for Hong Kong women living in the UK, and regularly hosts various events and gatherings with an average attendance of 12-16 people.

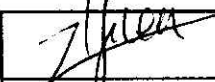

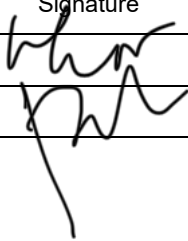
