1. Objectives and Activities

The purpose of the Life Is For Living Foundation is to support and improve the wellbeing of individuals and communities through charitable activities, outreach, and fundraising initiatives.

The charity aims to promote positive life experiences, provide support where needed, and raise funds to deliver meaningful charitable impact.

2. Activities and Achievements

During the financial year, the charity focused on fundraising and delivering charitable support through its activities.

Key highlights include:

- Raising funds through organised fundraising activities totalling £10,580
- Receiving donations of £2,888
- Delivering charitable activities with expenditure of £9,252

These activities contributed directly to the charity's objectives by enabling support and services to be provided to beneficiaries.

3. Financial Review

The charity reported total incoming resources of £13,468 for the year.

Total expenditure amounted to £11,317, with the majority spent on charitable activities (£9,252), supported by fundraising costs of £1,960 and other expenses of £105.

This resulted in a net surplus of £2,151 for the year.

The charity's closing bank balance at 05 April 2026 was £2,151.

4. Reserves Policy

The charity aims to maintain a small level of reserves to ensure it can continue its operations and meet any short-term financial commitments.

At the year end, the charity held £2,151 in reserves, which will be used to support future activities.

5. Structure, Governance and Management

The charity is governed by its trustees, who are responsible for the overall management and direction of the organisation.

The trustees meet as required to oversee activities, financial management, and decision-making.
