Related Party Transactions		During the period 1 September 2024 to 31 August 2025, the charity received donations totalling £50,038.58 from Mr Clive Rook, a trustee of the charity from inception on 22 August 2024 until his resignation as Chair and trustee on 8 July 2025. These comprised two

		donations of £25,000 each (on 22 and 23 January 2025), both made under Gift Aid, and a payment of £38.58 representing a refund received personally by Mr C Rook from a third-party supplier which was forwarded to the charity. In the preceding stub period (22 to 31 August 2024), the charity received an initial donation of £6,500 from Mr Rook under Gift Aid. All donations were made on terms consistent with arm's length giving, no benefit was conferred on Mr C Rook in return, and Mr C Rook took no part in any trustee decision concerning the application of his donations.

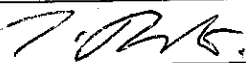
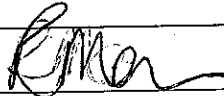

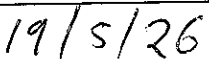
