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Activities

Objects: 1. TO PROMOTE FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE INHABITANTS IN THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BRENT AND WESTMINSTER AND THE SURROUNDING AREA THE PROVISION OF FACILITIES FOR RECREATION OR OTHER LEISURE TIME OCCUPATION OF INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE NEED OF SUCH FACILITIES BY REASON OF THEIR YOUTH, AGE, INFIRMITY OR DISABLEMENT, FINANCIAL HARDSHIP OR SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC CIRCUMSTANCES OR FOR THE PUBLIC AT LARGE IN THE INTERESTS OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND WITH THE OBJECT OF IMPROVING THE CONDITION OF LIFE OF THE SAID INHABITANTS. 2. TO ADVANCE IN LIFE AND HELP YOUNG PEOPLE IN THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BRENT AND WESTMINSTER AND THE SURROUNDING AREA THROUGH: (A) THE PROVISION OF RECREATIONAL AND LEISURE TIME ACTIVITIES PROVIDED IN THE INTEREST OF SOCIAL WELFARE, DESIGNED TO IMPROVE THEIR CONDITIONS OF LIFE; (B) PROVIDING SUPPORT AND ACTIVITIES WHICH DEVELOP THEIR SKILLS, CAPACITIES AND CAPABILITIES TO ENABLE THEM TO PARTICIPATE IN SOCIETY AS MATURE AND RESPONSIBLE INDIVIDUALS. 3. TO ADVANCE PUBLIC EDUCATION IN THE CARE AND UPBRINGING OF CHILDREN IN PARTICULAR BUT NOT EXCLUSIVELY BY: (A) PROVIDING PRACTICAL SKILLS TO BETTER SUPPORT THEIR CHILDREN'S DEVELOPMENT AND ENGAGE WITH THEIR CHILDREN. (B) PROVIDING INFORMATION, ADVICE AND OPPORTUNITIES FOR PEER SUPPORT; (C) IMPROVING COMMUNICATION AND PARENTING SKILLS TO IMPROVE AND FOSTER HEALTHY RELATIONSHIPS AND STRENGTHEN FAMILY BONDS. 4. TO PROMOTE SOCIAL INCLUSION FOR THE PUBLIC BENEFIT BY PREVENTING PEOPLE FROM BECOMING SOCIALLY EXCLUDED, RELIEVING THE NEEDS OF THOSE PEOPLE WHO ARE SOCIALLY EXCLUDED AND ASSISTING THEM TO INTEGRATE INTO SOCIETY, PRIMARILY THROUGH PROVIDING SOCIAL AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES AND EVENTS INVOLVING THE LOCAL COMMUNITY DIRECTED TO PROMOTING SOCIAL INCLUSION. FOR THE PURPOSE OF THIS CLAUSE 'SOCIALLY EXCLUDED' MEANS BEING EXCLUDED FROM SOCIETY, OR PARTS OF SOCIETY, AS A RESULT OF ONE OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING FACTORS: UNEMPLOYMENT; FINANCIAL HARDSHIP; YOUTH OR OLD AGE; ILL HEALTH (PHYSICAL OR MENTAL); SUBSTANCE ABUSE OR DEPENDENCY INCLUDING ALCOHOL AND DRUGS; DISCRIMINATION ON THE GROUNDS OF SEX, RACE, DISABILITY, ETHNIC ORIGIN, RELIGION, BELIEF, CREED, SEXUAL ORIENTATION OR GENDER RE-ASSIGNMENT; POOR EDUCATIONAL OR SKILLS ATTAINMENT; RELATIONSHIP AND FAMILY BREAKDOWN; POOR HOUSING (THAT IS HOUSING THAT DOES NOT MEET BASIC HABITABLE STANDARDS; CRIME (EITHER AS A VICTIM OF CRIME OR AS AN OFFENDER REHABILITATING INTO SOCIETY).

We deliver weekly youth clubs, monthly social activities for adults, and community wellbeing programmes that reduce isolation, promote inclusion, and strengthen community cohesion. Summary of the purposes of the charity as set out in its governing document	The charity exists to improve the wellbeing and life opportunities of Sudanese and wider local communities in Brent, Westminster and surrounding areas by providing recreational and educational activities, supporting young people and families, developing skills and community participation, and promoting social inclusion for individuals facing disadvantage or social exclusion.

The charity was registered on 4 November 2024 and did not undertake any formal charitable activities, projects, or services during the reporting period ending 31 August 2025. During this initial period, the trustees focused on establishing the organisation, developing its governance arrangements, and engaging with members of the Sudanese and wider local communities.
Statement confirming whether the trustees have had regard to the guidance issued by the Charity Commission on public benefit	The trustees confirm that they have had regard to the Charity Commission's guidance on public benefit when planning and carrying out the activities of the Sudanese and Wider Community Club Association. The trustees believe that the charity's activities further its charitable purposes for the benefit of the Sudanese and wider local community by promoting community cohesion, relieving social isolation, advancing education, supporting health and wellbeing, and providing opportunities for cultural and social engagement. The trustees are satisfied that the charity's activities provide a clear public benefit in accordance with the Charity Commission's guidance.

The Sudanese and Wider Community Club Association was registered as a charity on 4 November 2024. During the reporting period, the charity was in its establishment and organisational development phase and did not undertake any formal charitable activities. The trustees focused on setting up the charity's governance arrangements, administrative systems, and operational framework to support the future delivery of its charitable objectives. As no charitable activities were carried out during the reporting period, there were no direct beneficiaries reached and no measurable outcomes or wider public benefits generated during this time. The trustees are committed to developing the charity's programmes and activities in future reporting periods to support the Sudanese community and the wider community in accordance with the charity's objectives.
