The work towards the objects has made progress through:

- Media coverage, e.g., of the proposal to ban social media for children.
- The TV documentary broadcast on C4 'Poisoned – Killer in the Post' which created a call for change, and featured two Trustees.
- A Daily Mirror feature that included two Trustees and highlighted the need for internet regulation to reduce harms.
