TO ADVANCE THE EDUCATION OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC CONCERNING HEDGEHOG WELFARE AND CONSERVATION THROUGH THE PROVISION OF INFORMATION AND ADVICE DESIGNED TO INCREASE THE UNDERSTANDING OF THE NEEDS OF HEDGEHOGS IN THEIR NATURAL HABITATS.

**Activities:** To provide a safe and secure rescue for injured, sick and orphaned hedgehogs to recuperate and recover prior to release back to their natural and safe environment where possible. To offer sanctuary for hedgehogs unable to return to nature where possible. To advance the education of the public, encouraging

care of the natural spaces within their scope to further enhance hedgehog existence.

## Examiners Report

This is the independent Examiner's Report to the members of Hazelbury Bryan Hedgehog Rescue.

I report on the accounts of the Charity for the year ended 30<sup>th</sup> September 2025 in respect of an examination carried out under Regulation s.43 of the Charities Act 1993 ('the Act')

### Respective responsibilities of the Trustees and the Independent Examiner
