TO PROVIDE FOR THE RELIEF OF PEOPLE IDENTIFIED AS NEURODIVERSE AND ASSOCIATED CONDITIONS AND TO PROVIDE CARE AND LEARNING SUPPORT SERVICES TO ALL INDIVIDUALS AND THEIR FAMILIES WHO ARE RECOGNISED AS HAVING A LEARNING DISABILITY OR ANY OTHER SPECIAL NEEDS ASSOCIATED WITH A LEARNING DISABILITY; 2.
