Summary of the purposes of the charity as set out in its governing document	Para 1.17	The charity's purposes are to relieve poverty and hardship by providing food, essential supplies and support services, including essential life skills sessions, job readiness referrals and signposting services, to homeless individuals and low-income families. The charity also aims to promote social inclusion for the public benefit by preventing social exclusion, relieving the needs of people who are socially excluded and assisting them to integrate into society.
Summary of the main activities in relation to those purposes for the public benefit, in particular, the activities, projects or services identified in the accounts.	Para 1.17 and 1.19	During the reporting period, the charity focused on its establishment and organisational development following its registration as a Charitable Incorporated Organisation. The trustees concentrated on establishing appropriate governance arrangements, opening a bank account, developing operational procedures and exploring relationships with local organisations and community partners to support the future delivery of the charity's objectives. The charity received donations totalling £400.79, the majority of which were contributed by the Chair to support the charity's initial establishment and future activities. No charitable programmes or public benefit projects were delivered during the reporting period and no charitable expenditure was incurred. The funds have been retained to support the commencement of the charity's

		activities in the following financial period.

During the year, the trustees focused on establishing the charity's governance, administrative procedures and operational framework. Initial funding was received to support future activities, and preparations commenced for the delivery of the charity's objectives. No charitable activities were undertaken during the reporting period.
