The trustees present their report with the receipt and payment account of the The Divine Light Charity for the year ended 30 April 2026.

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

The objectives of The Divine Light Charity are summarised as follows:

Summary of the purposes of the charity as set out in its governing document:

The Prevention or relief of poverty and financial hardship anywhere in the world by providing grants to individuals in need, charities or other organisations working to prevent or relieve of hunger, poverty, education, medical treatment, training and all the necessary support designed to enable individuals, irrespective of race, colour, religion, gender, disabilities, to generate a sustainable income and be self sufficient.

Summary of the main activities in relation to those purposes for the public benefit, in particular, the activities, projects or services identified in the accounts:

The main activities of the charity were to donate funds to the UK registered charities with the same objectives and purpose. In addition, the charity provided financial assistance to overseas individuals and organisation that fulfil the criteria set by the trustees.

Statement confirming whether the trustees have regard to the guidance issued by the Charity Commission on public benefit:

The trustees have due regard to the guidance issued by the Charity Commission on public benefit.

Contribution made by volunteers:

The charity did not use any volunteers during the period.

Achievements and Performance:

The main achievements of the charity was to raise funds from the UK and then donate them to those charities which shared the same objectives of providing relief and assistance to poor and needy, financial assistance to people displaced during the wars and natural disasters. The Charity donated £390 to Cancer Research UK and £280 to Great Ormond Street Hospital. The Charity also donated £6,283 to overseas charities having the similar objectives.

Financial Review:

The Charity raised funds of £8,250 from UK donors and spent £6,953 towards charitable objectives. The other admin costs were around £745. At the year end the charity had £5,552 in the bank account which will be utilised to spend on charitable objectives in the forthcoming periods.

Statement explaining the policy for holding reserves stating why they are held:

The trustees have a policy of holding enough reserves to meet with the day to day running costs of the charity, except where there is a need to save the funds for any special projects or purposes. Amount of reserve held is £5,000. The charity is not in deficit.

No material uncertainties as a going concern. The charity has enough funds in the bank account and will have financial support from the trustees to meet with any unexpected costs.
