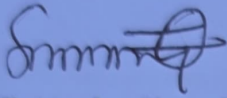
When planning our activities for the year, the board of pastors have considered the Commission's guidance on the public benefit, and particularly the specific guidance on charities for the advancement of religion.

Independent examiner's statement

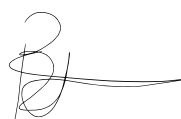
