TO PROMOTE PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT AND COMBAT SOCIAL ISOLATION FOR THE PUBLIC BENEFIT BY OFFERING STRUCTURED VOLUNTEERING PROGRAMS AT THE COMMUNITY HUB AND CAFE. 3.4 RELIEF OF SICKNESS TO RELIEVE THE MENTAL DISTRESS OF INDIVIDUALS OF THOSE IN NEED BY OFFERING A SAFE AND SUPPORTIVE ENVIRONMENT, PROMOTING WELL-BEING THROUGH PEER SUPPORT, SOCIAL ACTIVITIES, AND ACCESS TO INFORMATION ON MENTAL HEALTH RESOURCES. 3.5 RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES TO PROVIDE RECREATIONAL AND LEISURE ACTIVITIES THAT PROMOTE MENTAL AND PHYSICAL WELL-BEING, CREATIVITY, AND PERSONAL DEVELOPMENT, SUCH AS ARTS AND CRAFTS SESSIONS, CULTURAL ACTIVITIES, AND OTHER CREATIVE PURSUITS. 3.6 COMMUNITY CAPACITY BUILDING TO EMPOWER SOCIALLY EXCLUDED PEOPLE WITHIN THE COMMUNITY FOR THE PUBLIC BENEFIT BY PROVIDING TARGETED SUPPORT AND RESOURCES THAT ADDRESS THEIR UNIQUE NEEDS AND CHALLENGES, INCLUDING TRAINING AND EMPLOYMENT SUPPORT. 3.6 NOTHING IN THIS CONSTITUTION SHALL AUTHORISE AN APPLICATION OF THE PROPERTY OF THE CIO FOR THE PURPOSES WHICH ARE NOT CHARITABLE IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 7 OF THE CHARITIES AND TRUSTEE INVESTMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT 2005 AND SECTION 2 OF THE CHARITIES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 2008.
