Objects: 1.1 TO ADVANCE THE ARTS AND CULTURE FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE PUBLIC, PARTICULARLY, BUT NOT EXCLUSIVELY, BY PROMOTING, DEVELOPING AND FACILITATING ACCESS TO THEATRE AND OTHER PERFORMANCES, AND CREATIVE WORKS;1.2 TO ENCOURAGE THE UNDERSTANDING AND APPRECIATION OF THE ARTS, PARTICULARLY (BUT NOT LIMITED TO) THE PERFORMING ARTS BY PROVIDING, PRESENTING, PRODUCING, ORGANISING, CREATING ACCESS TO, MANAGING AND/OR CONDUCTING PERFORMANCES OR CREATIVE WORKS OF CULTURAL VALUE TO THE COMMUNITY;1.3 TO ADVANCE EDUCATION FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE PUBLIC, PARTICULARLY BUT NOT EXCLUSIVELY, IN THEATRE, PERFORMANCE AND THE ARTS;1.4 TO ADVANCE HEALTH FOR THE PUBLIC BENEFIT, PARTICULARLY (BUT NOT LIMITED TO) THROUGH ACTIVITIES RELATED TO THE CREATIVE AND PERFORMING ARTS;1.5 TO PROMOTE SOCIAL INCLUSION FOR THE PUBLIC BENEFIT BY PREVENTING PEOPLE FROM BECOMING SOCIALLY EXCLUDED, RELIEVING THE NEEDS OF THOSE PEOPLE WHO ARE SOCIALLY EXCLUDED AND ASSISTING THEM TO INTEGRATE INTO SOCIETY. FOR THE PURPOSE OF THIS OBJECT, ?SOCIALLY EXCLUDED? MEANS BEING EXCLUDED FROM SOCIETY, OR PART OF SOCIETY, AS A RESULT OF BEING A MEMBER OF A SOCIALLY AND ECONOMICALLY DEPRIVED COMMUNITY;1.6 TO PROVIDE FOR THE RECREATION OF CHILDREN, YOUNG PEOPLE AND ADULTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE PUBLIC BY PROVIDING FACILITIES AND SERVICES TO THEM (INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, ACCESS TO PERFORMANCE, THEATRE AND THE ARTS) IN THE INTERESTS OF SOCIAL WELFARE WITH THE OBJECT OF IMPROVING THEIR CONDITIONS OF LIFE.
