MAXIMISING ACCESSIBILITY TO OUR EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES, IN ORDER TO FOSTER UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN PEOPLE FROM DIFFERENT BACKGROUNDS.NOTHING IN THIS CONSTITUTION SHALL AUTHORISE AN APPLICATION OF THE PROPERTY OF THE CIO FOR THE PURPOSES WHICH ARE NOT CHARITABLE IN ACCORDANCE WITH [SECTION 7 OF THE CHARITIES AND TRUSTEE INVESTMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT 2005] AND [SECTION 2 OF THE CHARITIES ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND) 2008].
