Objects: 1. THE PROMOTION OF RELIGIOUS HARMONY - THROUGH ART INSTALLATIONS, CULTURAL EXHIBITIONS AND EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMES, THAT LINK ART, HISTORY, AND HERITAGE - FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE PUBLIC BY: (A) EDUCATING THE PUBLIC IN DIFFERENT RELIGIOUS BELIEFS INCLUDING AN AWARENESS OF THEIR DISTINCTIVE FEATURES AND THEIR COMMON GROUND TO PROMOTE GOOD RELATIONS BETWEEN PERSONS OF DIFFERENT FAITHS;(B) PROMOTING KNOWLEDGE AND MUTUAL UNDERSTANDING AND RESPECT OF THE BELIEFS AND PRACTICES OF DIFFERENT RELIGIOUS FAITHS.
