THE OBJECTS OF THE CIO ARE: 3.1 THE ADVANCEMENT OF HEALTH AND SAVING OF LIVES IN UKRAINE AND ELSEWHERE FOR THE PUBLIC BENEFIT IN SUCH WAYS AS THE CHARITY TRUSTEES THINK FIT, INCLUDING IN PARTICULAR BUT NOT EXCLUSIVELY BY SUPPORTING THE PROVISION OF PHYSICAL AND PSYCHOLOGICAL REHABILITATION TO PEOPLE AFFECTED BY WAR IN UKRAINE. 3.2 THE RELIEF OF PEOPLE IN NEED IN UKRAINE AND ELSEWHERE WHO ARE VICTIMS OF WAR, NATURAL DISASTER OR CATASTROPHE IN SUCH WAYS AS THE CHARITY TRUSTEES THINK FIT.
