Objects: THE OBJECT[S] OF THE CIO [IS][ARE] THE OBJECT OF THE CHARITY IS FOR THE PUBLIC BENEFIT TO PROMOTE COMMUNITY PARTICIPATION IN THE HEALTHY RECREATION OF OPEN WATER SWIMMING IN DAVENTRY, WARWICKSHIRE & SURROUNDING AREAS IN PARTICULAR BY: 1. WORKING WITH AND THROUGH LOCAL AGENCIES SUCH AS WEST NORTHAMPTONSHIRE COUNCIL, CANALS & RIVERS TRUST, DAVENTRY COUNTRY PARK TO INCREASE LEVELS OF PARTICIPATION IN OPEN WATER SWIMMING; 2. PROMOTING AND PROVIDING PROGRAMMES TO SUPPORT WATER SAFETY THROUGH ACTIVITIES SUCH AS LIFEGUARD TRAINING IN ASSOCIATION WITH THE ROYAL LIFE SAVING SOCIETY; 3. PROMOTING AND PROVIDING FACILITIES AND SERVICES FOR OTHER WATER BASED ACTIVITIES ESPECIALLY AS THEY RELATE TO WATER SAFETY SUCH AS KAYAKING AND PADDLEBOARDING; 4. DEVELOPING, IN ASSOCIATION WITH DAVENTRY COUNTRY PARK THE PHYSICAL INFRASTRUCTURE TO IMPROVE THE SAFETY AND QUALITY OF THE SWIMMING EXPERIENCE; AND 6.
