Objects: THE OBJECTS OF THE CIO ARE TO PROMOTE THE ATTAINMENT OF GOOD EDUCATION AND HEALTH IN NIGERIA FOR THE PUBLIC BENEFIT IN PARTICULAR BUT NOT EXCLUSIVELY BY I. SUPPORTING AND PROMOTING ACCESSIBLE AND INCLUSIVE EDUCATION, PARTICULARLY, FOR UNDERPRIVILEGED CHILDREN, BY PROVIDING RESOURCES, AND LEARNING INITIATIVES THAT ENHANCE ACADEMIC GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT. II. AIDING RESEARCH AND INNOVATION IN EDUCATION, BY ASSESSING EDUCATION STANDARDS IN RURAL COMMUNITIES, IDENTIFYING EDUCATIONAL CHALLENGES, SOCIAL ISSUES, AND BARRIERS TO LEARNING; AND USING THE FINDINGS TO DEVELOP SOLUTIONS, AND IMPROVE OVERALL EDUCATIONAL OUTCOMES FOR THE PUBLIC BENEFIT. III. SUPPORTING EDUCATIONAL BODIES AND INSTITUTIONS TO STRENGTHEN EDUCATIONAL FRAMEWORKS BY USING DATA DRIVEN RESEARCH TO PROVIDE SUPPORT FOR STUDENTS AND EDUCATORS, ENSURING IMPROVED ACCESS TO QUALITY EDUCATION. IV. PROMOTING DIGITAL LITERACY, ENTREPRENEURIAL EDUCATION, YOUTH EMPOWERMENT, AND INCLUSIVE EDUCATION BY CREATING INTERACTIVE MEDIA COMMUNITIES AND PROVIDING ACCESSIBLE EDUCATIONAL PLATFORMS TO ADVANCE TECHNOLOGY-DRIVEN EDUCATION. V. DEVELOPING PRACTICAL AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP SKILLS FOR CHILDREN AND ACADEMIC PROFESSIONALS IN URBAN AND RURAL COMMUNITIES BY ORGANISING WORKSHOPS, TRAINING PROGRAMMES, AND EDUCATIONAL EVENTS AIMED AT IMPROVING ACADEMIC, VOCATIONAL, AND PROFESSIONAL COMPETENCIES, THEREBY IMPROVING THEIR SKILLS AND EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES. VI. SUPPORTING THE PROVISION OF HEALTHCARE DELIVERY TO POOR AND LOW INCOME FAMILIES, PARTICULARLY CHILDREN, IN THE RURAL PARTS OF AFRICA WHERE ACCESS TO PUBLIC MEDICAL FACILITIES AND HEALTHCARE CENTRES ARE LIMITED. VII. SUPPORTING HEALTHCARE AND HEALTHCARE EDUCATION TO PREVENT SPECIFIC LIFE-THREATENING ILLNESSES AMONGST YOUNG FAMILIES THROUGH AWARENESS, KNOWLEDGE AND SIMPLE SELF EXAMINATION TECHNIQUES TO ENABLE EARLY DETECTION FOR REFERRAL TREATMENT. VIII. SUPPORTING RESEARCH ON HEALTH-RELATED ISSUES AND SECTOR CHALLENGES BY CARRYING OUT RESEARCH TO BETTER UNDERSTAND MEDICAL CHALLENGES, IMPROVE HEALTHCARE POLICIES, AND DEVELOP INNOVATIVE SOLUTIONS FOR PUBLIC HEALTH CONCERNS. IX. PROMOTING GENERAL HEALTH AWARENESS BY DEVELOPING AND SUPPORTING LOCAL CHAPTERS THAT WILL CONTINUE THE WORK ESTABLISHED BY THE MEDICAL MISSIONS.
