Objects: THE OBJECTS OF THE CIO ARE SUCH PURPOSES AS SHALL BE EXCLUSIVELY CHARITABLE ACCORDING TO THE LAWS OF ENGLAND AND WALES AS THE CHARITY TRUSTEES IN THEIR ABSOLUTE DISCRETION FROM TIME TO TIME THINK FIT, IN PARTICULAR BUT NOT LIMITED TO: 3.1 THE RELIEF OF THOSE IN NEED BECAUSE OF YOUTH, AGE, ILL-HEALTH, DISABILITY, FINANCIAL HARDSHIP OR OTHER DISADVANTAGE; 3.2 THE ADVANCEMENT OF THE ARTS, CULTURE OR HERITAGE; 3.3 THE ADVANCEMENT OF EDUCATION; 3.4 THE PROMOTION OF HUMAN RIGHTS (AS SET OUT IN THE UNIVERSAL DECLARATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS AND SUBSEQUENT UNITED NATIONS CONVENTIONS AND DECLARATIONS) THROUGHOUT THE WORLD BY RAISING AWARENESS OF HUMAN RIGHTS ISSUES; 3.5 THE ADVANCEMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION OR IMPROVEMENT; 3.6 THE ADVANCEMENT OF BOTH PHYSICAL AND MENTAL HEALTH OR THE SAVING OF LIVES; 3.7 THE RELIEF OF FINANCIAL NEED AND SUFFERING AMONG VICTIMS OF NATURAL OR OTHER KINDS OF DISASTER IN THE FORM OF MONEY (OR OTHER MEANS DEEMED SUITABLE) FOR PERSONS, BODIES, ORGANISATIONS AND/OR COUNTRIES AFFECTED, INCLUDING THE PROVISION OF MEDICAL AID.
