IN FURTHERANCE OF THAT OBJECT BUT NOT OTHERWISE, THE CHARITY MAY PROVIDE STRUCTURED WORKSHOPS, COURSES, MENTORING, LEARNING RESOURCES, LIBRARIES, TALKS AND EVENTS; DEVELOP AND SHARE EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS; AND WORK WITH SCHOOLS, COMMUNITY ORGANISATIONS AND OTHER PARTNERS.
