- 12 Laptops/Mice/Carry Cases/Headphones for Learning & Development - £9,657

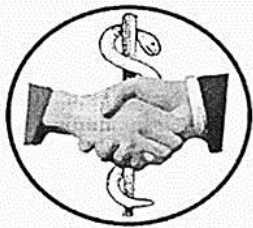
