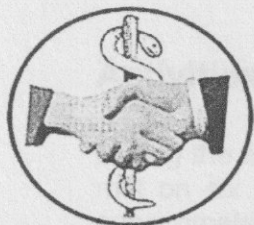

Activities/Achievements during 2024/25
