If the charity's income is surplus for this purpose it is available for special help for children in the village and also for relieving, either generally or individually, persons resident in the parish of East Ruston who are in conditions of need, hardship or distress.

**Achievements**

The Trustees report last year started with our concern regarding the flooding on South Fen, what a difference a year can make. Whilst grazing was not possible during 2024, hopefully 2025 will see grazing return. Drainage work has been done in preparation for the grazing.

The Conservation Volunteers have continued to maintain areas of the common that have already been cleared as well as cutting gorse on new areas.

Peter Frizzell has continued to control any Japanese Knotweed on the common by the Council houses.

East Ruston Parish Council re-elected Mr Heath Brooks and Mr John McLeod as their representative Trustees.

A new contractor was instructed to trim all the hedges surrounding the "common" and the trustees are very pleased with the work.

The Trustees continue to support East Ruston Primary school by renting the area behind the school for woodland activities.

A panto trip was organised for children from the village but unfortunately it was later discovered that, unbeknown to the clerk, people from outside the village had managed to obtain tickets. Steps have been taken to ensure this does not happen again.

The Trustees again sponsored a Christmas meal in the Village Hall for those eligible.

37 cheques of £45 were issued before Christmas.





The Trustees have been concerned this year that because of the continual flooding of South Fen permanent damage may have been caused to the grazing. Whilst the grazing has been offered to last years grazier we will need to see if there will be any grass available.

If we are unable to obtain any rent it will obviously affect next years income considerably.

The Conservation Volunteers have continued to maintain areas of the Common that have already been cleared as well as cutting gorse on new areas.

Peter Frizzell has continued to control any Japanese Knotweed on the Common by the Council houses.

As always the hedges around the Common have been maintained by our contractor and although he will now be retiring he has assured us that he has a colleague who will continue the cutting.

The Trustees paid for children and parents to visit Bewilderwood and 32 cheques of £45 each were issued in December. For a second year a Christmas meal in the Village Hall, for parishioners and friends, was sponsored by the Trustees. Because of the success of last years event the Trustees donated £1200 as more villagers wished to attend.

### **Structure, governance and management**

The charity is constituted and governed by a Scheme of the 8<sup>th</sup> April 1971 and an Order dated 9<sup>th</sup> August 2006.

Trustees are nominated by the Parish Council and other organisations linked with the charity's interests and are appointed by the existing trustees.

### **Objectives and activities**

The charity's principal object is to provide a fuel allowance to pensioners, widows and poor persons resident in the parish of East Ruston. If the charity's income is surplus for this purpose it is available for special help for children in the village and also for relieving, either generally or individually, persons resident in the parish of East Ruston who are in conditions of need, hardship or distress.

### **Achievements**

The Countryside Stewardship scheme has continued this past year with the area known as "The Tip" grazed. 
**Reserves Policy**
