INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT

Report to the Trustees on the accounts for the year ended 31 December 2024

Respective responsibilities of Trustees and Examiner

Independent Examiner's statement

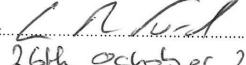
In connection with our examination, no matter has come to our attention:

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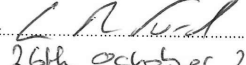
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TRUSTEES' REPORT

For the year ended 31 December 2024

REFERENCE AND ADMINISTRATIVE INFORMATION

The Charity was established in 1914 consolidating various gifts and legacies left by numerous benefactors from the community of Hodnet. The Trustees serving throughout the year were Dr J R Miles, Mr D M Morgan, Mrs J M Parker, Mr J H Powell, Mrs A Taylor and Mrs G M Roberts.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

The Charity is governed by its Trust Deed. Trustees are appointed in accordance with the terms of the Trust Deed and selected on the basis of their availability, personal competence and familiarity with the aims of the charity. The Trustees meet two or three times each year to review donations and to deal with any other business. In considering donation policy, the Trustees give due regard to the guidance on public benefit published by the Charity Commission.

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

The Trust was established for general charitable purposes and the policy of the Trustees is to direct donations mainly to the benefit of the poor of the Parish of Hodnet and their medical and social needs.

During the year the Trust made donations totalling £11,406.98 to 9 organisations in furtherance of its aims.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

The Charity received income of £33,732.93 during the year. Charitable donations and management expenses totalled £21,446.96, causing a surplus of £12,285.97 on charitable activities which was taken to reserves.

ASSETS

At the year end, the Trust held a diversified fund of cash, property and investments valued at £1,517,512.38. The investments are managed on behalf of the Trust by CQS.A.
