Accounts

Finances

Accounts for the year to 31 December 2024 are enclosed.

There was a modest surplus of income over expenditure, despite a significant increase in expenses, particularly for the Annual Open Exhibition and in Admin costs, including printing, postage and an upgrade of the web-site. The Open had an extended run but was largely supported by part of the grant from the Heritage Lottery Fund. The Anna Airy Awards were again generously sponsored by the The Arts Societies of South-East Suffolk and Woodbridge.

Membership numbers and subscriptions received are increasing steadily, and sales of the 150th Anniversary book went a good way towards covering costs. Art-work sales at the Open and Small Works exhibitions were at about the same level as in 2023.

Apart from the Open, the grant from Heritage Lottery Fund was used for additional events and activities within the Art at the Heart programme. These will be accounted for separately for the period ended 28 February 2025, when the grant expires.

The state of the Society's finances is satisfactory, with adequate funds in reserve, but there are concerns about the impact that rising costs will have for the current year and beyond.

Annual subscriptions for 2025 became due on 1 January and are unchanged at £25 for Members and £15 for Friends. Payment can be made by on-line transfer to the Society's account at: sort code 53-61-24, number 71334432, or by cheque (payable to Ipswich Art Society) to the Treasurer at 89 Bucklesham Road, Ipswich, IP3 8TT. Thank you. If you will not be renewing your membership this year, it would be helpful if you could let us know, please.
