The trustees present the annual report together with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31 December 2021.

Objectives and activities

Objects and aims

The charity aims to benefit the area comprising of the town of Northallerton and the parish of Brompton and to relieve either generally or individually persons resident in that area who are in conditions of need, hardship or distress through the application of income to such persons. The charity shall promote education while providing for any school in the area, such benefit as is not normally provided by the local education authority or for the specific financial assistance of persons under 25 years who are resident in the area.

Objectives, strategies and activities

The charity makes grants to each of the parishes, each of the incumbents and each of the local schools who display a need in accordance with the charities aims and objects. The charity also makes grants to individuals and organisations who propose the use of those grants in line with the charities aims and objects.

Public benefit

The Kettlewell Charity applies its income to the public benefit in accordance with the Charity Commission Scheme 224, 422.

Income is provided on a proportional basis as set out in the Scheme to The Vicars of the Ecclesiastical Parishes of Northallerton and Brompton for the provision of Religious Texts and the Relief of Need Grants are therefore made on an application basis to seven local schools and any other scheme or proposal that meets with the Trustees approval.

The trustees confirm that they have complied with the requirements of section 17 of the Charities Act 2011 to have due regard to the public benefit guidance published by the Charity Commission for England and Wales.

Achievements and performance

The charity made generous grants to parishes, incumbents and schools and individual grants to specific organisations in 2021.

Statement of Trustees' Responsibilities


