FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31ST MARCH 2024

The trustees present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 31st March 2024. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019).

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

The main aims are to promote and assist the general good of all old people in the urban district of Rayleigh and to assist any charitable body or bodies financially or otherwise in the furtherance of such purposes.

Significant activities

The main activities carried out by the charity are the provision of lunches and social services.

Public benefit

The Trustees have carried out the charity objectives and activities, having had due regard for the Charity Commission's guidance on public benefit.

ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE

The charity continues to provide valuable support to elderly local residents, giving them lunches and social interaction and support. The charity has been able to open for lunches on a second day each week to enhance its objectives.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Financial position

The principal funding sources for the charity in the year continued to be in the form of catering income and use of the day centre. The charity has been fortunate to receive a large donation of £100,000 from the winding up of Essex Age Concern in the year. This has provided financial security in the medium term. Incoming resources for the year amounted to £114,010. Resources expended for the year amounted to £31,837. The net income for the year was £82,173. As at the year end, the charity had funds amounting to £103,519.

Reserves policy

To avoid problems if funding difficulties were to happen, the charity agrees to keep a certain level of financial reserves to ensure that main operations can continue.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing document

The charity is controlled by its governing document, a deed of trust and constitutes an unincorporated charity.

Its constitution was adopted 30th November 1961 and amended on 4th October 1962 and 7th February 1973.

Recruitment and appointment of new trustees

The Charity actively seeks to recruit Trustees from as wide a spectrum as possible, the principal criteria being that they are supportive of the charitable aims. Those interested in becoming a Trustees are encouraged to take the opportunity to discuss the role and the work of the charity with existing Trustees.



1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charity, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2019)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Charities Act 2011. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

Income

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably. Non monetary donations are received in the form of general volunteers providing their time free of charge and in respect of the reduced rental agreement as described in the notes to the financial statements.

Expenditure

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Tangible fixed assets

Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life.

- Plant and machinery - Straight line over 10 years and Straight line over 5 years
- Fixtures and fittings - Straight line over 10 years and Straight line over 5 years

Taxation

The charity is exempt from tax on its charitable activities.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.
