**Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of Atlantic Peace Foundation  
for the year ended 24 May 2025**

I report to the charity trustees on my examination of the accounts of the charity for the year ended 24 May 2025 which are set out on pages 3 to 4.

**Responsibilities and basis of report**

As the charity trustees you are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the requirements under the Charities SORP 2019 (FRS 102).

Having satisfied myself that the accounts of the charity are eligible for independent examination, I report in respect of my examination of the accounts as carried out under Section 145 of the Charities Act 2011 (the 2011 Act). **Independent Examiner's Statement**
