Governing Document

The charity is constituted by a deed of trust dated 8th February 1963.

Objectives and Activities

The object of the charity is to make payments for the benefit of charitable purposes and objects, at the discretion of the trustees, but primarily for charitable objects within the parishes of Isygarreg and Uwchgarreg in the former county of Montgomeryshire, Powys, Wales. The charity is funded by its own investments.

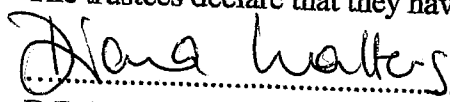
The trustees have compiled with their duty to have given due regard to the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit when reviewing the charity's aims and objectives and in planning its future activities.

In the year ended 5th April 2022 the income received by the charity amounted to £52,365 and there were administrative expenses of £12,368.

Charitable payments of £72,634 were made during the year to 5 organisations. Grants in excess of £1,000 were made to the Machynlleth Tabernacle Trust, Derwenlas Community Centre, Dyfi Eco Valley Partnership and Harrow 450 Fund.

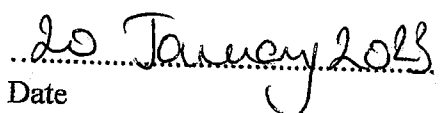
The financial policy of the charity is to keep the capital fund intact and to provide grants out of income, current or accumulated.

**Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of Garthgwynion Charities
for the Year Ended 5th April 2022**

I report on the accounts of the trust for the year ended 5th April 2022, which are set out on pages 2 to 3.

Respective Responsibilities of Trustees and Examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts. The charity's trustees consider that an audit is not required for this year under section 144(2) of the Charities Act 2011 (the 2011 Act) and that an independent examination is needed.

It is my responsibility to :

- examine the accounts under section 145 of the 2011 Act ;
- to follow the procedures laid down in the general Directions given by the Charity Commission under section 145(5)(b) of the 2011 Act ; and
- to state whether particular matters have come to my attention.

Basis of Independent Examiner's Report

My examination was carried out in accordance with the general Directions given by the Charity Commission. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes consideration of any unusual items or disclosures in the accounts, and seeking explanations from you as trustees concerning any such matters. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit and consequently no opinion is given as to whether the accounts present a 'true and fair view' and the report is limited to those matters set out in the statement below.
